**RESOLUTION**

**Sub.: Enhancement of Pre-Matric Scholarship for the ST/SC boarder students prosecuting their studies in the residential Schools of ST & SC Development Department and hostellers of School and Mass Education Deptt. Institutions.**

Pre-Matric Scholarships are given to all the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe students studying in the Residential Schools of ST & SC and M.E. Schools and High Schools of S & ME Deptt. including the hostels of Special ST Hostels of ST & SC Dev. Deptt.

Due to considerable rise in prices of food articles and other essential commodities of daily use, the existing rate of Pre-Matric Scholarship is considered inadequate to meet the maintenance of boarder students. Considering the inadequacy of existing rate of Pre-Matric Scholarship given to the SC/ST boarder students. Government after careful consideration have been pleased to enhance the rate of Pre-Matric Scholarship in respect of students residing in aforesaid hostels keeping the rate of Pre-Matric Scholarship of day scholar, enhanced vide letter No. 19082 dt. 11.05.2010 unchanged. The enhanced rate of Pre-MS of boarders as per details given below will be effective from 1<sup>st</sup> May, 2011 until further orders:-


