





**PROCEEDING OF THE MEETING OF THE TRIBES ADVISORY COUNCIL HELD IN  
THE CONFERENCE HALL NO. 3 NEAR R.D. DEPTT. ON 13.05.2011 AT 11.00 A.M.**  
\*\*\*\*\*

- (1) The Tribes Advisory Council Meeting was held on 13.05.2011 at 11.00 A.M. under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Odisha. The list of Hon'ble Members and Officers who attended the meeting is annexed at **Annexure-1**.
- (2) At the outset Hon'ble Chief Minister welcomed all the members and briefed them regarding the steps taken for the welfare of the tribals in the State. The steps taken for construction of 100 seated hostels, increase in stipend amount of boarders, provision of bicycle and uniforms, opening of legal aid clinics etc. was placed before the members.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary, ST & SC Development Department placed the agenda items for deliberation before the TAC.

- (3) After detailed discussion on the various agenda items as well as some additional items, the following decisions were taken.
- (3.1) The Proceeding of last TAC Meeting held on 11.06.2010 was confirmed.
- (3.2) The Action Taken Report on the decisions taken in the last TAC Meeting held on 11.06.2010 was discussed and approved.
- (3.3) The Annual Administration Report to be sent by His Excellency, the Governor of Odisha regarding administration of Scheduled Areas for the year 2008-09 and 2009-10 was approved by the TAC. While approving the report Hon'ble Members observed that the health strategy outlined by the Health Department to provide a PHC for a population of 15, 000 instead of 20, 000 should be assessed only after ascertaining whether a PHC @ 20, 000 population has been provided in the Scheduled Areas.
- (3.4) Regarding the reports submitted by the SCSTRTI for inclusion of Putiya Community in the ST list of Odisha, the members observed that a small committee consisting of some TAC Members and some officers of the ST & SC Development Department should make a field visit and ascertain the actual position. It was decided that a small committee under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister, ST & SC Development Department will make a field visit and submit the report in the next TAC.
- (3.5) The members noted the recommendation of the high power delegation under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister, ST & SC Development Department who had visited Kandhamal, had wide ranging discussion with Community Leaders and Civil Society Organisations. Accordingly the recommendations for substitution of "KUI" with "KUI (KANDHA)" at Sl. No. 31 of the ST list of Odisha was approved for recommendation to Government of India.



- (3.6)** The Hon'ble Members noted the recommendations of the National Commission for Scheduled Tribes in their 3<sup>rd</sup> Report for the year 2007-08. The recommendations pertaining to service safeguards were discussed and it was agreed to bring about an amendment in the ORV Act in view of some recent judgments of Hon'ble High Court and Hon'ble Supreme Court.
- (3.7)** The issue regarding inclusion of "Ho" and "Kolha" tribal language was discussed at length by the Hon'ble Members. It was decided to recommend to Govt. of India (Ministry of Home Affairs) for inclusion of the Ho language in the 8<sup>th</sup> Schedule of the Constitution of India.
- (3.8)** The proposal of inclusion of Muka Dora / Nuka Dora communities in the ST list of Odisha was discussed. Keeping in view the ethnic status study done by SCSTRTI regarding the status of Muka Dora / Mooka Dora / Nuka Dora / Nooka Dora community, the TAC finally resolved to recommend the case for inclusion in the ST List of Odisha as a new entry.
- (3.9)** The Hon'ble Members of TAC noted the achievements relating to settlement of individuals and community claims under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006. While being appreciative of the fact that Odisha ranks as number-1 in the Country, some of the members raised concern regarding non-availability of sketch map while issuing the Individual Titles. It was agreed that a general circular to all Collectors will be issued under the signature of the Chief Secretary, Odisha. The members were also informed regarding the efforts to cover the individual title holders under various development schemes.
- (3.10)** Detailed discussion was held regarding up-gradation of High Schools of ST & SC Development Department to +2 level. While approving the up-gradation of 3 High Schools as recommended by the committee under the Chairmanship of Development Commissioner, the members observed that at least one high school in each of the TSP Blocks should be up-graded. Shri Chakradhar Paik, Hon'ble Member as well as Padmashree Tulsi Munda, Hon'ble Member, TAC emphasized on the need to provide educational opportunity to the ST youths. Most of the members suggested to open +2 courses in all 3 streams i.e. Arts, Science and Commerce. It was agreed to examine the matter and take expeditious action.



- (3.11)** Regarding the proposal of W & CD Department to earmark some funds under Article 275 (1) for construction of buildings for newly opened Anganwadi Centres, it was decided that the respective PLCs should take action on this.
- (3.12)** The Hon'ble Members raised concern regarding the amendment of the ORV Act, especially in the context of its applicability to contractual appointments. The house was informed that the preliminary exercise regarding the amendment to relevant provisions has been done and the process would be expedited. It was also agreed that provisions relating to consequential seniority issues in the light of the recent judgments should be addressed to protect the interest of the STs and SCs.
- (3.13)** Regarding the reconstitution of the Project Level Committee of I.T.D.A.s, it was decided to continue with the existing arrangements.
- (3.14)** The TAC discussed the suggestion of Shri Srinath Soren, Hon'ble MLA of Udala to enquire into the ethnic status of Jhadu Bindhani and it was agreed that the SCSTRTI will take up an ethnic status study for this community.
- (3.15)** The proposal for correction of entries Bhima Saura and Sudda Saura made in **Sl. No. 59 of ST list of Odisha as Bhima Saura and Sudha Saura / Suddha Saura** was discussed. It was decided that SCSTRTI will examine the matter and submit its report, which will be placed in the next TAC for taking a final decision.
- (4)** Apart from the agenda items certain other issues were discussed and the following decisions were taken.
- (4.1)** The Hon'ble members were informed regarding the initiation of a Bill to regulate the issuance and verification of Caste Certificates.
- (4.2)** The members raised concern regarding non-filling up of back log vacancies in various departments.
- (4.3)** Hon'ble Minister, ST & SC Development Department raised the issue of Jhodia Communities for inclusion in ST list of Odisha as they are very backward and fulfill the requisite criteria. It was decided that matter would be re-examined and appropriate action shall be taken up by the Department with Government of India.
- The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Hon'ble Chairman and all the members.
